- Part-time (EVET) students enrolled in one of these courses are advised to have one line free on their timetable at their homeschool, in or order to complete set work.

The following lists a sample of courses on offer to students at Southern Cross. All courses are offered to Year 11 & 12 (Stage 6) students and run across 2 years.

Southern Cross has a wide variety of Nationally Accredited Certificate II and III Courses on offer on-site. Full-time students have the opportunity to choose 2 or 3 courses depending on their pattern of study. All courses are offered to Year 11 & 12 (Stage 6) students and run across two years.

Depending on students interests the college also offers a choice of career pathways, Stage 6 Industry (HSC Plus) Pathway or Academic (ATAR) Pathway.

These are in addition to Certificate I Courses in Automotive, Business, Construction, Hospitality and Retail offered to students in Year 9 & 10 (Stage 5).

BAKING

CERTIFICATE II

This course will provide you with the skills for a career as a baker in a skills shortage industry. Get invaluable experience working in an industry-equipped commercial pastry kitchen, produce the sweetest of treats on a commercial scale and learn how to manage retail operations.

- Product cookie and sweets products

EDUCATION SUPPORT

CERTIFICATE III

The Nationally Accredited Certificate III in School Based Education Support provides the basic skills to work effectively in a range of school and educational settings.

This qualification provides opportunities for students to work under the supervision and direction of a teacher and school learning support officer to assist in classroom activities, school routines, and the care and management of students with special needs.

Sample units of study

- Support behavior in children and young people
- Contribute to the health and safety of students
- Work effectively with students and colleagues

COMMUNITY DANCE, THEATRE AND EVENTS

CERTIFICATE III

This qualification provides you with skills and knowledge suitable for those interested in a career in the creative and performing arts. It reflects the role of individuals working in a variety of community-based performance and production contexts, including Dance, Drama and Music.

Sample units of study

- Develop vocal technique for use in performance
- Integrate rhythm in dance or movement technique
- Develop musical theatre and performance techniques

HUMAN SERVICES (ALLIED HEALTH)

CERTIFICATE III

This course is closely related to the Health Services (Nursing) qualification but with an emphasis in Allied Health such as dietetics, occupational therapy, physiotherapy, psychology, radiography and speech pathology. The course will help you turn your passion for community health into a rewarding career.

Sample units of study

- Recognise healthy body symptoms
- Maintain patient records
- Communicate and work in health or community services
