### COLLEGE UNIFORM AND PRESENTATION POLICY - 2024

The College Uniform is to be worn **to and from** the College every day other than on days when a student has a course that requires course specific PPE which can be worn all day as indicated below by \*

The College Uniform and Presentation Policy is guided by both school based requirements and what is reflected as sound work health and safety (WHS) practices.

All students upon enrolment from Term 1 2024, will need to have purchased an SCCC school bag.

**The College Uniform** consists of (in addition to the table below for Course Specific requirements):

- Black lace up leather flat soled shoes
- Black College socks for gentlemen, white with black stripe ankle length for ladies
- College pants/skirt (Skirt is required to be on the knee)
- College blouse/shirt
- College blazer (Compulsory in Terms 2 and 3)
- College tie for gentlemen (Optional Terms 1 and 4, Compulsory in Terms 2 and 3)
- College, grey knitted, jumper (Optional) - no other tops are to be worn
- College cap (Optional) - no other caps are to be worn

Specific uniform/equipment and Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) are published on the following page.

*Please note: Where students are not wearing either the correct College uniform or the correct protective equipment/uniform, may be excluded from practical class activities and be issued with appropriate theoretical learning activities to complete. They may also be sent home to retrieve these items if deemed necessary. Parents/Carers will be notified by SMS if this is applicable.*

#### **Presentation for all students:**

- Two pairs of earrings may be worn at a maximum
- No other facial jewellery e.g. nose/lip/face piercings
- Hair to be neat and well groomed at all times (hair will need to be tied back/restrained in some courses due to WH&S requirements).
- Hair colour must be natural.
- Nails to be kept short.
- Clear nail polish.
- No excessive make-up or eyelash extensions or the like.
- The College shirt should be tucked in at all times.
- Male students may grow and maintain facial hair on the provision that it is well groomed and does not exceed a level 2 clip.

**Additional Information:**

- Students who are scheduled for 'block delivery' in Technical Trades classes in the morning and/or afternoon are permitted to arrive at and depart from the College wearing approved specialist uniform/PPE. At all other times students are required to both arrive and depart in full College uniform.
- Students undertaking courses of study in Hospitality, Dance, Drama and/or Entertainment must wear their Full College Uniform at all times except in some selected lessons as instructed by their course teacher. Students in these cases will be provided with time to change in and out of their College/Performance/Hospitality Uniform.
- The wearing of 'hoodies' or the like are not supported by the College and these items may be confiscated.
- If a student is unable to wear any of the aforementioned due to an unforeseen circumstance the College will require a parent/carer note. If approved, the student will be provided with a 'Uniform Pass' for the day. Circumstances of this nature should not exceed one day.
- Students are not permitted to chew gum while on the College property or in College uniform.
- Students who are noted to be non-compliant with the aforementioned uniform requirements may be sent home to either change or engage in remote learning - parents/carers will receive an SMS if this is applicable.
